

AN ARTISTS' CHRISTMAS 2011 TIME LINE & GUIDELINES

- July 29** Completed Artist Entry Forms (your commitment to participate) are due in order to be considered for the exhibition. **Camp Fire USA will work with distinguished area art professionals to juror the acceptance of artworks from 90 artists.**
- Mid-August** Artist acceptance letters will be mailed out with all pertinent information.
- September 2** Art drop-off will be conducted at a location in Fort Worth to be announced in the acceptance letter. If unable to drop off the artwork during these times, Camp Fire will work with you to find an agreeable time.
- September 9** Artworks are photographed for inclusion in the Art Exhibition catalog. Artists may also submit a 4"x5", 300 dpi digital image to be used for the catalog.
- Early October** All artwork will go live on AnArtistsChristmas.org for pre-bidding and "Buy it now" auctions for Camp Fire supporters.
- November 4** RSVPs for attendance to the gala are due. Each participating artist receives two complimentary reservations. **You must RSVP in order to receive your two complimentary reservations.**
- November 11** **An Artists' Christmas 2011 Gala** will be held at Omni Hotel Fort Worth.

- Original works in all media, either two or three-dimensional, are preferred.
- Each artist may submit only one entry, unless a pair, or separate parts, is designed to be exhibited as a single work of art.
- Camp Fire USA reserves the right to return material that is not representative of its mission to serve youth or that is unsuitable for exhibition and auction. We are unable to accept artworks that include nudity, violence or subject matter of a sexual nature.
- Camp Fire USA provides insurance coverage of artwork while it is securely stored, during the exhibition period, and during the Auction Dinner at Omni Hotel Fort Worth. Participating artists are responsible for insurance during shipping, if applicable.
- The expertise and opinion of each artist is appreciated; however, Camp Fire USA reserves the right to make final installation decisions.
- Camp Fire USA reserves the right to photograph works of art for promotion and documentation.
