Camp Fire offered the free training to child care providers to help them create a healthy food environment for the kids in their care. Participants learned how to prepare nutritious meals for children, as well as received tips on buying healthy, low-cost foods. The project was made possible through a grant from Share Our Strength.

Each summer, Camp Fire partners with the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Fort Worth to send kids, like Medora (left) and Lyric, to camp.
