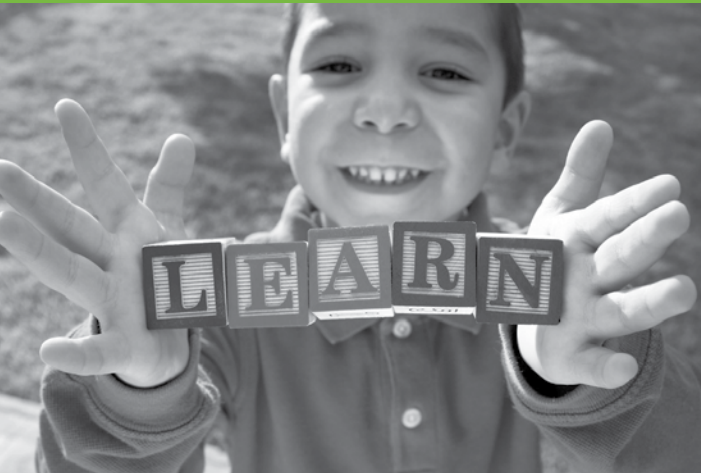

## ECMI Renewal Training

The Child Care Administrator's Credential must be renewed every three years. Camp Fire not only supports you in achieving this credential, but through the **ECMI Renewal** process, you maintain your credential, as well.
