Job Summary: The Development Intern will work closely with and learn directly from seasoned members of the Development team with over 28 years of collective experience in development and marketing. The Development Intern will assist with activities in support of Camp Fire's organization-wide fundraising efforts. This role will report to the Development Manager and is approximately a15-hour per week hybrid in office/remote position, starting on or after July 5, 2021 and extending to December 2021.

Essential Functions:

- Generate, acquire signatures, and mail thank you letters for donors
- Follow up calls to donors
- Special events logistics and planning, including signature fundraiser, An Artists' Christmas in November featuring Emmitt Smith
- Assist Development Manager in coordinating and managing logistical details of each event
- Help manage timelines for special events
- Set up and document committee meetings' minutes/actions/to do's
- Assist by coordinating and communicating with potential and selected artists for An Artists' Christmas
- Manage and coordinate art images and art submitted for An Artists' Christmas
- Assist in keeping invitation lists current and accurate
- Assist with soliciting and securing in-kind donations for events
- Assist in producing and printing letters/mailing for donor solicitation and acknowledgment
- Help manage mailings for events, ensuring mail lists current, coordinate event mailings to meet timeline goals
- Assist in managing third party and new demographic fundraising opportunities
- Help manage North Texas Giving
