Job Summary: Develop, plan and implement daily curriculum which is developmentally appropriate, provided by the Child Development Center in collaboration with Frog Street and Conscious Discipline practices. Ensure that routines are carried out in a manner that is consistent with best practices and NAEYC standards. This includes routines related to diapering, toilet training, hand washing, tooth brushing, eating, napping and transitioning between activities. Supervise and participate in group activities with the children.

Essential Functions:

- Must be able to observe children through sight and sound
- Implement positive/Conscious Discipline techniques
- Maintain appropriate classroom management
- Ability to stand, lift, pull, push, carry and hold children and/or objects up to approximately 40 pounds

- Experience working with young children
- Ability to interact with children and families in a positive and approachable manner
